Message from General Secretary, Manipur State Branch



Dear Colleagues,

I want to express my deepest gratitude for your courage and selflessness. In the face of the ongoing communal conflict, your dedication to supporting affected communities is a testament to the very best of humanity.

However, I must emphasise that your safety is our absolute highest priority. Communal tensions can create highly volatile, unpredictable, and rapidly changing environments. To ensure you can continue to serve safely, you must strictly adhere to the following security protocols:

Safety protocols: We should always wear our Red Cross Jackets to identify ourselves and avoid misidentification. Our vehicles should be painted with Red Cross emblems.

Maintain absolute neutrality: In a communal conflict, our role is strictly humanitarian service. Do not engage in political, religious, or partisan discussions, either in person or on social media. Our neutrality is our greatest shield.

Never travel or work alone: Always operate in your assigned teams. Ensure your team leader knows your exact location at all times, and establish clear check-in intervals.

Respect boundaries: Strictly observe all local authority directives, curfews, and safety perimeters. Do not venture into unfamiliar areas or areas identified as high-risk by security briefs.

De-escalate and withdraw: If you encounter an aggressive crowd, a checkpoint, or a tense situation, do not argue or attempt to mediate. De-escalate calmly, withdraw immediately to a safe location, and report the incident to the management.

Your life and well-being are irreplaceable: No delivery of relief materials or support is worth risking your safety. Please look out for one another, stay vigilant, and exercise maximum caution.

Thank you for your invaluable service. Please stay safe.
